Requirements to enroll:

- Proof of vaccination required (14 days after second dose)
- 50lbs lifting requirement
- ability to utilize math and English skills
- ability to work early morning or late night shifts

The 4-weeks of training is <u>paid</u> and covers:

- Heavy equipment certification in Raymond Easi Reach, Counter Balance Forklifts, and Walkie End Rider
- Practical work experience in an actual warehouse, transportation and logistics environment in the LIL Training Program
- \$15.75 / hour with 37.5 hours per week supporting the community at North York Harvest Food Bank.

95% attendance is required to graduate. After completing four weeks of intense essential skills training, you will have certified experience working with large-scale warehousing and distribution organizations to create pathways to full-time employment.

Graduates will be given preferences for currently existing opportunities in Mississauga, Brampton, and Bolton. People must be able to commute to one of the sites. Work opportunities start at \$18+/hour.
