We are excited to announce that Camp Meeting 2023 at the International Centre is just around the corner, with our shared vision of "Growing Spiritual Champions" guiding us throughout the event. As we prepare for this special gathering, we would like to provide you with some important information regarding the children's programs during the camp meeting.

As previously mentioned, we have arranged programs specifically designed for children during the morning services of the camp meeting. However, please note that due to the afternoon Ordination Service requirements, there will be no afternoon program available for the children. The programs will cater to children from the Kindergarten, Primary, and Juniors Divisions of the Sabbath School, with an age range of four years up to 12 years. For our teenage attendees, the Youth Department will provide separate programs. These programs will commence at 9:30 a.m. and conclude at 12:30 p.m.

To ensure a smooth registration process, please be advised that registration for the children's program will begin at 9:00 a.m. at Aviation Ballrooms A, B, and C. For safety purposes, parents/guardians must present a valid photo I.D. when registering their child/children. The photo I.D. must be shown to the program staff during the registration process and will be required for checkout. Additionally, only the parent or guardian who registered the child/children will be allowed to collect them. To facilitate this process, please ensure that you have the child safety wristband issued to you during registration, as it will be required for the release of your child/children. If you are registering a child aged 0-3 years old, please note that you must remain in the room with your child/children. Kindly remember to collect your children promptly after the conclusion of the program at 12:30 p.m.

We kindly request that you remind parents bringing their children to the programs to provide snacks for them. However, please ensure that any food items brought from home do not contain nuts or nut butters, considering allergies and the safety of all the children involved. The Children Ministries Department may provide a box of apple juice for the children as an additional refreshment.

Lastly, we humbly ask for your prayers for the success of the Camp Meeting, the children's programs, and the Ontario Conference Sessions. Your support and prayers are greatly appreciated as we strive to create a spiritually enriching and safe environment for all participants.
